

## SORTING INSTRUCTIONS RESIDUAL WASTE CONTAINER

### WHAT CAN BE PUT IN

- Files
- Ashes (cooled down)
- Cutlery, crockery
- Bandages, tampons, hygiene articles
- Flower boxes, pots made of plastic or clay
- Dispersion paints (hardened)
- Printer cartridges
- Bike tyres
- Lighters
- Plaster waste
- Glass panes, broken pieces, mirror glass
- Halogen lamps
- Handbags
- Dog excrement
- Cat litter and small animal litter
- Basket work
- Cosmetic articles
- Foods with packing
- Dirty paper, cardboard, cartons
- Saw dust/wood shavings
- Foam, foam rubber
- Toys (not electrical)
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Road sweepings
- Wallpaper
- Medicine
- Carpets
- Nappies



### WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED

- Hazardous wastes (U)
- Bulky wastes which prevent emptying the container (bulky waste collection can be requested for such waste material).
- All wastes which belong to the categories papers, biowaste, yellow bag or environment bus and which can be disposed of through the appropriate container or bag.



### GENERAL INFORMATION

The containers are available in 60 l, 80 l, 120 l, 240 l, 770 l und 1,100 l sizes.

10 of the possible 26 collections for the container size 60 l, 80 l, 120 l und 240 l are covered by the minimum charge.

The containers are collected every 2 weeks. For the 770 l and 1.100 l container sizes 13 of the possible 26 collections are covered.

For the large containers there is the possibility of a 4 week, 2 week and under certain conditions a weekly collection.

At some recycling centres residual waste can be given in for a fee. This can only be accepted up to an edge length of 2 m.
