

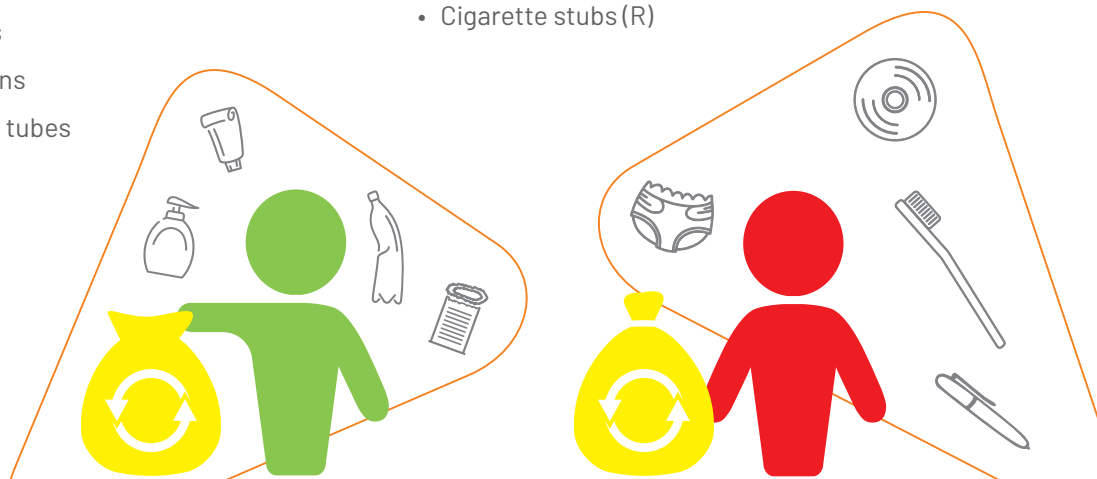
SORTING INSTRUCTIONS YELLOW BAG – THIS IS THE RIGHT WAY TO SEPARATE

WHAT BELONGS IN THE YELLOW BAG E.G.

- Pharmaceutical blister packs
- Empty paint buckets (plastic or tinplate)
- Drinks and milk cartons
- Yoghurt cups and lids
- Food cans
- Ready meal trays
- Aluminium foil
- Shampoo bottles (empty)
- Spray cans (empty)
- Washing up liquid bottles
- Cooking oil bottles (plastic)
- Polystyrene packaging (not insulating material)
- Food packaging made of plastic (empty)
- Soup packs
- Pet food cans
- Toothpaste tubes

WHAT DOES NOT BELONG IN THE YELLOW BAG E.G.

- CDs and discs (R)
- Disposable razors (R)
- Lighters (R)
- Hygiene articles (R)
- Cat litter (R)
- Ceramic pots (R)
- Children's toys made of plastic (R)
- Transparent covers (R)
- Ball point pens (R)
- Full food packages (R)
- Paper/Cardboard/Cartons (P)
- Wallpaper (R)
- Nappies (R)
- Toothbrushes (R)
- Cigarette stubs (R)
